

**HOW TO MEASURE FOR REPLACEMENT SLINGS:** Measurements should be taken while the sling material is still installed tightly in the furniture frame. Measuring an old sling that has been removed from the frame is not accurate as the fabric may have stretched out over time. Measure only installed slings, even if they are cut or ripped. For the width measurement, we require the distance from the center of the sling rail channel to the center of the opposing sling rail channel. Don't be tempted to add to the measurement. Measure to the nearest 1/8". We will add the necessary fabric for seam allowances.

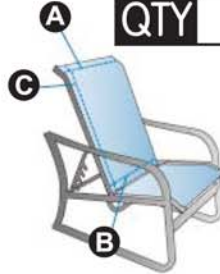

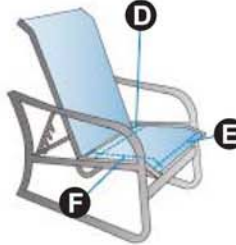

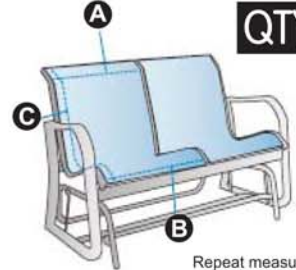

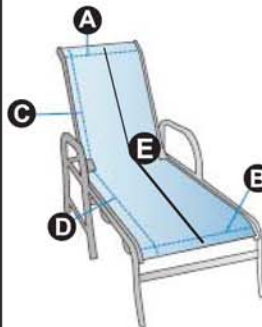
